With this filing, Ameritech is proposing to withdraw certain broadband transmission services from its F.C.C. Tariff No. 2, as required by the Commission upon use of the forbearance relief pursuant to FCC Memorandum Opinion and Order No. 07-180 (the "Order"), released October 12, 2007.

The *Order* granted relief for all of the optical and packet switched broadband transmission services currently offered by the AT&T Operating Companies (e.g., Frame Relay, ATM, Ethernet, Remote Network Access, SONET, Optical Network and Wave-Based services), with the exception of certain Frame Relay and ATM services operating below 200 Kbps in each direction. The *Order* does not grant forbearance with respect to traditional, TDM-based DS-1 and DS-3 transmission services, nor to any services that do not provide a transmission capability of over 200 kilobits per second in each direction. This filing proposes to implement the relief granted by the *Order*.

As the Commission is aware, AT&T previously filed modifications to its Tariff No. 2 on January 7, 2008, that would have implemented the relief granted by the *Order*. AT&T subsequently withdrew those modifications prior to their effective date, as authorized by the special permission granted by the Commission on January 17, 2008. For purposes of maintaining numerical continuity and facilitating Commission review of AT&T's tariffs, AT&T has numbered the above-referenced tariff pages to reflect the existence of those proposed (but withdrawn) modifications. Thus, each of the above-referenced modified tariff pages in this filing has a revision number that is one step advanced from the revision number indicated for that page in AT&T's January 7, 2008 proposed tariff filing.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
