The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry issued January 3, 2008, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for hearing. The hearing was scheduled to begin on March 5, 2008.
- (2) On January 25, 2008, upon the request of counsel for Northeast Ohio Neighborhood Health Services, Inc. (NEON), the attorney examiner conducted a prehearing conference by telephone. Because of delays in completing discovery, counsel for NEON requested that the hearing be postponed to a later date. AT&T Ohio consented. The parties agreed to reschedule the hearing for June 10-12, 2008.
- (3) In accordance with the request and consent of the parties, and finding no undue delay or prejudice to a party, the March 5, 2008, hearing in this matter shall be canceled and rescheduled for June 10, 2008. The hearing shall continue as necessary through June 12, 2008. The hearing shall begin at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time in Hearing Room 11-F at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. To expedite the hearing, any exhibits shall be premarked and filed by June 3, 2008. The parties should file any expert testimony in accordance with Rule 4901-1-29(A), O.A.C.



ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon the parties, their respective counsel, and all interested persons of record.


