Dear Mr. Coe:

As per our telephone conversation of Friday, February 8, 2008, the forfeiture assessed for violation of 49 C.F.R. § 395.3(a)(2) was incorrectly assessed and thus has been waived because you were not placed out of service for the violation. Additionally, the forfeiture assessed for violation of 49 C.F.R. § 392.9a(a)(1) has been waived because you have obtained the necessary interstate operating authority. While all violations reported by the citing officer in the driver/vehicle examination report are valid and will be listed in your SafetyNet record, only the out-of-service violation of 49 C.F.R. § 392a(a)(1) will be included in your history of violations for purposes of determining future penalty actions and your safety rating.

Your agreement to the terms of this letter will eliminate the need for a hearing on these violations and will enable the Staff to dismiss this case.
