Previously, the MSL rates for the FirmRate Advantage Month-To-Month, One Year Term and Three Year Term have been the same. We are reducing the One Year Term and Three Year Term MSL, thus they are now being identified separately. This filing also adds FirmRate Plus Plan as an eligible plan for the 15% Long Distance Usage Discount Promotion.
