The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 16, 2007, Lynda T. Givens filed a complaint alleging that she was improperly billed for gas service by Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.
- (2) Duke filed an answer denying the material allegations of the complaint.
- (3) A prehearing conference was conducted on December 19, 2007.
- (4) On January 15, 2008, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. In support of the motion, the parties stated that they have settled this matter and that all issues raised in the complaint have been resolved.
- (5) In view of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed.
