The Company will waive the monthly charges for those Sprint Integrated Local Services ordered under this promotion in the 12th, 24th and 36th months when customers subscribe to a one, two or three-year term agreement, respectively. Services and features for which charges will be waived include all local exchange services and features contained in the Sprint Integrated Local Service as specified in this Tariff and all monthly charges for optional services and features ordered from other sections of this Tariff in conjunction with Integrated Local Services. Charges for long distance services subscribed to in conjunction with the Sprint Integrated Local Service are not waived under this promotion. The waiver also does not include CPE, maintenance, nonrecurring and service connection charges, or usage charges of any kind (i.e. long distance usage charges, operator services, directory assistance, etc.). Customer will be responsible for all applicable taxes, surcharges and fees calculated based on the value of the MRC before the waiver is applied. Customers who discontinue the services subscribed to under this promotion prior to the end of their term agreement will be assessed all charges waived under this promotion. Subscription to this promotion is available through June 30, 2007, unless it is sooner changed or canceled by the This promotion is not available in conjunction with the Installation Waiver Promotion III offered under this tariff.

8. BUSINESS PRODUCT DESCRIPTIONS

1. Local Exchange Service

Local Exchange Service consists of services furnishing switched communication in connection with one-way and/or two-way information transmission points within a Local Calling Area offered pursuant to this tariff. Local Exchange Services provide a Customer with a connection to the public switched network which enables the Customer to:

- 1. receive calls from other stations on the public switched telephone network; access the Company's Local and IntraLATA Calling Services as set forth in this tariff;
- 2. access intraLATA, interLATA, intrastate, interstate and international calling services provided by other certified common carriers;
- 3. access the Company's operator and customer service center for service related assistance; access toll-free telecommunications services such as 800, 888, 877 NPA; and access 9-1-1 service for emergency calling.

Local Exchange Service provides an individual access line for the transmission of two way switched voice or data communication within a local calling area. The individual access line is the connecting facility between a Customer's premise and a serving central office that provides Customer access to the switched network for placing and receiving calls. The individual access line also enables the Customer to access the service of long distance carriers.

3. Service Connection Charges (SCC)

Service connection charges are nonrecurring charges that apply for the connection, reconnection, move or change of local telephone service. One or more SCC may apply to each Customer order depending upon the work functions performed. The charges specified herein do not contemplate work being performed at a time when overtime wages apply due to the request of the customer.

All changes in the location of a customer's service from one premise to another will be treated as a new installation. SCCs do not apply when service is disconnected.

Service Connection Charges are associated with, but not necessarily limited to service establishment, and Telephone number changes.

1. Description

Primary Service Connection Charge - Applies for the establishment of service, per location, (T) per occasion. The charge is for receiving, recording and processing information necessary to execute a customer's request for service and initial connection or establishment of service.

Secondary Service Connection Charge - Applies to the second or additional line of a new (N) access line installation and connection. This charge applies only when the second or additional line is ordered simultaneously with the initial connection for service.

Transfer of Service Charge, Primary Line - Applies to the first line of a Transfer of Service (TOS) Order, when a customer requests a move or change in physical location. This charge applies whether a customer changes telephone number or not. If, in addition, the Customer requests the telephone number be changed, a separate charge may apply.

Transfer of Service Charge, Secondary Line - Applies to the second, or third, etc., line of a Transfer of Service (TOS) Order, when a customer requests a move or change in physical location. This charge applies whether a customer changes telephone number or not. If, in addition, the Customer requests the telephone number be changed, a separate charge may apply.

Change Order - Subsequent Charge - Applies for changes in existing service such as changing a local access line or trunk from hunting to non-hunting or to resequence Also applies for charges or additions to features after initial hunting numbers. establishment of service. Applies to other customer-requested changes in service that are not specifically covered in other nonrecurring service connection charges.

<u>Technician Dispatch Charge</u> – Applies when travel to a subscriber's premises is required. Only one Technician Dispatch Charge applies per subscriber request at the same premises.

<u>Telephone Number Change Order Charge</u> - Applies to each telephone number change request/order associated with local access lines/trunk service or Remote Call Forwarding.

<u>Listing Change Charge</u> - Applies when a Customer requests/orders a change to add or delete a white pages listing or requests a change to add/delete listings. This charge also applies to a request for Non-Published or Non-Listed numbers.

4. Custom Calling Services

Custom Calling Services are optional service arrangements of central office features furnished to individual line customers. The following custom calling features are available within the exchange area of all exchanges served by a central office where facilities and operating conditions permit. Customers may subscribe to one or more of the following features.

A Feature Installation Change Charge applies in lieu of all other Service Connection Charges to establish or change one or more Custom Calling Features.

1. Features and Functions

- 1. Anonymous Call Rejection Allows customers to reject calls from calling parties that have blocked the delivery of their number and/or name. Calls are routed to an announcement. Anonymous Call Rejection is provided at no additional charge to Caller ID - Number Only and Caller ID with Name and Number Customers, subject to the availability of facilities. The feature is available to non-Caller ID subscribers for a flat monthly rate.
- 2. Call Forwarding- Provides an arrangement for transferring incoming calls to another (T)(N)telephone number one call at a given time unless the Customer also subscribes to Simultaneous Call Forwarding. Calls may be transferred to any telephone number.

The Call Forwarding customer is responsible for payment of toll, local usage sensitive or other charges associated with each call between the called number and the forwarded number. Call Forwarding shall not be used to extend calls on a planned and continuous basis to intentionally avoid the payment, in whole or in part, of local usage sensitive or message toll charges that would regularly be applicable between the station originating the call and the station to which the call is transferred. The Company will not provide identification of the originating telephone number to the call forwarding number.

- 1. Call Forwarding Variable Permits the Customer to automatically forward all incoming calls to another telephone number, until the customer deactivates the feature, and to restore it to normal operations at the Customer's discretion. If forwarded to a long distance number, the Customer will incur long distance charges. This feature is available to Business Customers only.
- 2. Call Forwarding Busy Permits the Customer to have all incoming calls automatically forwarded to a predetermined telephone number when the Customer's line is busy.
- 3. Call Forwarding Busy/No Answer Permits the forwarding of incoming calls when the Customer's line is busy or remains unanswered after a designated number of rings.

- Remote Call Forwarding Permits the Customer's calls to be automatically
 forwarded by the central office equipment to a predetermined number over local or
 long distance facilities. The terminating locations must have the capacity to accept
 incoming calls.

Remote Call Forwarding is offered where economically and technologically feasible. This feature will not be offered to locations which terminate the calls in a coin telephone instrument. Caller ID is not available to Remote Call Forwarding subscribers. Transmission quality may vary depending upon the distance and routing necessary to complete the forwarded call, therefore, may not be suitable for data transmissions.

A Change Order - Subsequent Charge applies for each change of a telephone number associated with Remote Call Forwarding.

- 6. <u>Remote Access to Call Forwarding</u> This feature allows the Customer to activate and deactivate their Call Forwarding feature and to change their forwarded to number from a location other than where their service is located.
- 7. Simultaneous Call Forwarding Provides the Customer that also subscribes to an appropriate call forwarding service the ability to forward multiple incoming calls simultaneously to another telephone number designated by the Customer. The Simultaneous Call Forwarding Customer must subscribe to sufficient facilities to adequately handle calls. The Simultaneous Call Forwarding Customer is responsible for the payment of charges (e.g., toll charges) for each call between the Simultaneous Call Forwarding equipped telephone line and the line to which the call is being forwarded.

1. Operator Assistance

When customers request that a call be handled in such a manner that operator assistance in completion of the call is necessary, such as alternate billing, person-to-person services, operator dialed or requests other special handling of the call, Operator Assistance surcharges apply as set forth within.

Busy Line Interrupt: Upon request of a calling party the operator will interrupt the call on the called line only if the calling party indicates an emergency.

<u>Busy Line Verify:</u> Upon request of a calling party the Operator will verify a busy condition on a called line. The operator will determine if the line is clear or in use and report to the calling party.

Operator Dialed: The end user places the call without dialing the designated number, although the capability to do it himself exists. The end user will dial "0" for local calls and long distance calls and then requests the operator to dial the called station.

<u>Person-to-Person</u>: Calls completed with the assistance of a Company operator to a particular person, station, department, or PBX extension specified by the calling party. Charges may be billed to the calling station, called station (collect), or a third number.

<u>Station-to-Station</u>: Refers to calls other than person-to-person calls billed collect or to a calling card or third number. Calls may be completed with or without the assistance of a Company operator.

Customers may obtain directory assistance in determining telephone numbers by calling the Directory Assistance (DA) operator. A maximum of two requested telephone numbers will be provided for each Directory Assistance call. A Directory Assistance Charge applies when customers request assistance in determining telephone numbers in the local calling area in which the customer receives local exchange services (local directory assistance), telephone numbers located outside the local calling area but within the customer's Home Numbering Plan Area (long distance directory assistance), or telephone numbers that are located outside the customer's Home Numbering Plan Area (national directory assistance).

When a customer requests operator assistance to place a call to Directory Assistance, the Operator Services Operator Dialed Call Placement Charge applies in addition to the Directory Assistance Charge. Directory Assistance calls that are alternately billed (collect, calling card or third number) will be assessed the applicable Operator Services Call Placement Charge.

Calls to Directory Assistance from lines of customers who have been certified by a registered physician or recognized agency as unable to use a directory because of a physical handicap are not subject to charge

The Directory Assistance Charge applies per call even if the customer requests telephone numbers that are Non-Published or otherwise not found by the automated directory assistance system.

After receiving a number by accessing Directory Assistance the customer has the option of having their call completed by either an operator or by depressing a specific digit on a Touch Tone telephone.

The DACC option is only available if the calling number and the number requested to be dialed are in the same metropolitan calling area. Customers who subscribe to Sprint Integrated Local Services must subscribe to one of the Block of Time Minutes specified in Section 9.13.3 for their usage-sensitive local exchange service. All Block of Time Minutes are provided on a per Customer location basis. All Integrated Local Services provided at a single Customer location must share the Block of Time Minutes option selected by the Customer. These minutes do not apply to long distance.

When a customer orders multiple high capacity (1.544 Mbps) facilities in conjunction with an Integrated Local Service, the sum of the channels, trunks or lines ordered for all such facilities at a single location under a single account must be equal to or greater than the required minimum quantity.
