ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 14, 17, and 18, 2008, the above-captioned complainants residing in a retirement center in Milford, Ohio filed complaints with the Commission alleging that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s (Duke) rates for electric service were too high.
- (2) On February 5 and 6, 2008, Duke filed its answers and motions to dismiss the complaints for failure to state reasonable grounds for complaint.
- (3) The Commission's Service Monitoring and Enforcement Department has contacted the complainants to discuss their concerns. After discussions with staff, complainants advised our staff that they do not wish to pursue their formal complaints. Accordingly, the Commission will dismiss these complaints without prejudice.


It is, therefore,


