On August 10, 2007, John Kavlich MD dba Patient First filed a complaint against Level 3 Communications, Inc. and AT&T Ohio. The complaint did not name Covad Communications ("Covad") as a respondent. By attorney examiner entry dated March 26, 2008, it was determined that Covad be joined as a necessary party respondent to the complaint and Covad was directed to file its answer by April 15, 2008.
