The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 28, 2007, AT&T Ohio filed its basic local exchange service (BLES) application pursuant to Section 4927.03, Revised Code, and Rule 4901:1-4-09, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-4-09(G), O.A.C., an incumbent local exchange company's BLES application will be automatically approved and become effective on the 121st day after the initial filing unless suspended by the Commission, the legal director, or an attorney examiner.
- (3) In light of fact that AT&T Ohio has 2 BLES applications currently pending before the Commission (the other BLES application is in Case No. 08-107-TP-BLS), both requiring significant Commission review, this matter shall be suspended consistent with Rule 4901:1-4-09(G), O.A.C., in order to provide the Commission with additional time to consider this request.

ORDERED, That the application be suspended in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
