The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 28, 2007, AT&T Ohio filed its basic local exchange service (BLES) application pursuant to Section 4927.03, Revised Code, and Rule 4901:1-4-09, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-4-09(G), O.A.C., an incumbent local exchange company's BLES application will be automatically approved and become effective on the 121<sup>st</sup> day after the initial filing unless suspended by the Commission, the legal director, or an attorney examiner.
- (3) In light of fact that AT&T Ohio has 2 BLES applications currently pending before the Commission (the other BLES application is in Case No. 08-107-TP-BLS), both requiring significant Commission review, this matter shall be suspended consistent with Rule 4901:1-4-09(G), O.A.C., in order to provide the Commission with additional time to consider this request.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the application be suspended in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,
