The Commission finds:





- (1) On December 31, 2007, Johnny Chin filed a complaint with the Commission alleging that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s (Duke) service had too many outages.
- (2) On January 18, 2008, Duke filed its answer and motion to dismiss the complaint for failure to state reasonable grounds for complaint.
- (3) On April 18, 2008, Mr. Chin filed a letter stating that Duke has installed a new transformer that has resolved his problem. Therefore, complainant has requested that his complaint be withdrawn. The request is reasonable and should be granted.

ORDERED, That the above-captioned case be dismissed without prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,
