The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 24, 2007, the complainant, Communication Options, Inc., through its counsel, filed a complaint in this case against the respondent, AT&T Ohio (AT&T). The complainant is a competitive local exchange carrier in Ohio under Certificate No. 90-9041 and the respondent is an incumbent local exchange carrier. The complaint involves a dispute between the parties concerning billing issues that have arisen with regard to four lines that were either changed or disconnected and with regard to the outstanding balance amounts for reciprocal compensation that the parties claim are owed.
- (2) The Commission's Docketing Department did not serve a copy of the complaint upon the respondent until September 7, 2007. Twenty days later on September 27, 2007, the respondent filed an answer to the complaint.
- (3) A settlement conference was held in January 2008 and, following that conference, settlement negotiations continued.
- (4) On May 2, 2008, the complainant filed a motion to dismiss based on the fact that the parties have settled this matter and all of the issues raised in the complaint have been resolved.
- (5) Due to the fact that the parties have reached a settlement of all issues involved in this case, the complainant's motion to dismiss
