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<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner, pursuant to the authority of Rule 4901:1-6-06, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), finds:

- (1) On May 16, 2008, Clertech.com, Inc. (applicant) filed an application seeking authority to provide competitive local exchange services in Ohio.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-6-06, O.A.C., states, in relevant part, that, without exception, all telephone-related applications filed pursuant to O.A.C., must include a current Chapter 4901:1-6, telecommunications application form for all telephone-related applications and zero-day notice filings. The rule continues by noting that failure to utilize the telecommunications application for any type of filing pursuant to Chapter 4901:1-6, O.A.C., as well as any failure to include the required attachments will result in immediate dismissal of the new application. The Commission has delegated authority to the legal director, deputy legal director, or the attorney examiner assigned to the case to issue an entry dismissing an application pursuant to this rule.
- (3) A review of the application in this case reveals that the applicant failed to file all of the requisite attachments and/or failed to explain why such attachments would not be applicable.
- (4) Based on the aforementioned deficiencies, the attorney examiner finds that this application should be dismissed pursuant to the authority of Rule 4901:1-6-06, O.A.C.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this application be dismissed in accordance with finding 4. It is, further,
