TELEPHONE SERVICE TARIFF
P.U.C.O. NO. 5
GENERAL EXCHANGE TARIFF
Glandorf Exchange

Customers have certain rights and responsibilities under the Minimum Telephone Service Standards (Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-5) (the "MTSS"). These safeguards can be found in the Appendix to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-5-03, which is entitled "Telephone Customer Rights and Responsibilities." These rights and responsibilities include complaint handling, ordering or changing service, service repair, payment of bills, and disconnection and reconnection of service. (N)

A. RATES AND THEIR APPLICATIONS

1. The following rates shall apply within the Base Rate Area which is defined as the Glandorf Corporation Limits as on the date of this tariff sheet, and not more than 500 feet beyond such limits.

2. The following rates apply outside the Base Rate Area, but within the Glandorf Exchange Area.

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C. EARLY PAYMENT DISCOUNT

Bills are rendered monthly on the first day of the succeeding month and the discount of twenty-five (25) cents per month will be allowed if the net bill is paid on or before the 10th of the month after date thereof. If not so paid, the gross amount will be payable.

D. LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

(T)

A late payment charge of \$1.00 or 5%, whichever is greater, will apply to regulated charges not paid at least nineteen (19) days after the postmark on the customer's bill. The late payment charge will not apply to any portion of the bill that is in bona fide dispute, any previous late payment fees included in the amount due, or to service establishment charges for lifeline services. Late charges are to be applied without discrimination.

E. BAD CHECK CHARGE

There will be a non-recurring charge of \$15.00 for each check returned to The Glandorf Telephone Co., Inc. by the Bank marked Insufficient Funds (NSF). This charge will apply unless the customer can establish that the charge should not be applied.

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G. BRIDGED SERVICE-COMBINED BUSINESS AND RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

1. Where a subscriber wishes to contract for two individual line main station services at two separate locations in the same exchange area, but also wishes to be able to answer calls for one station or either station at the other location, the arrangements described below are provided subject to the availability of the facility necessary to furnish satisfactory service.
2. Combined main station service may be employed where one station is at a business location and the other is at a residence or where both stations are at either business or residence locations. However, such an arrangement is permitted only on the premises of the same subscriber or where the subscriber at the residence location is associated in business with or is an employee of the subscriber at the business location.
3. In any arrangement for combined main station service, each station is assigned its own telephone number.
4. Combined main station service may be arranged so that the bells at both stations will ring when either station is called.
5. The rate for individual line business service applies for the business station and the rate for individual line residence applies for the residence station.

H. OBLIGATION AND LIABILITY OF THE TELEPHONE COMPANY

The Telephone Company's obligation to furnish exchange and toll service is dependent upon its ability to secure and retain without unreasonable expense, suitable facilities and rights for the construction and maintenance of the necessary pole lines, circuits, equipment, etc.

TELEPHONE SERVICE TARIFF
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The liability of The Telephone Company for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, or errors or defects in transmission occurring in the course of furnishing service or facilities and not caused by negligence of the subscriber, shall not exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge for the affected service or facility for the period of such impairment.

I. RESPONSIBILITY OF SUBSCRIBERS

The subscriber will be held responsible for all charges for telephone service rendered in connection with local and toll calls placed from the subscriber's telephone and for all toll messages received at such station of which the charges are reversed with the consent of the person answering the call.

J. DEPOSITS

(T)

When the Company assesses a deposit, it will do so based on a statewide average monthly bill in accordance with the MTSS.

K. INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS

All ordinary expenses of installation, maintenance and repairs in connection with equipment, facilities, and service provided by the Telephone Company, is borne by the company unless otherwise specified in the Local Exchange Tariff. In case of damage, loss or destruction
