## The Commission finds:

(1) On March 28, 2008, William Kusior, Jr., (the Complainant) filed a complaint against the Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison or Respondent) alleging improper billing and meter maintenance.

- (2) On April 14, 2008, Ohio Edison filed a motion in this docket for a 30-day extension to file its answer or other responsive pleading in this proceeding. In support of its motion, Ohio Edison submitted that the parties believed they could resolve the issues in this case. Ohio Edison's motion for a 30-day extension was granted by an attorney examiner entry issued on April 16, 2008.
- (3) On May 1, 2008, a joint motion to dismiss was filed by the parties. The joint motion submits that the parties have amicably resolved the issues in this complaint. The parties also request that the Commission dismiss this case with prejudice. Accordingly, the Commission finds that the parties' joint motion to dismiss with prejudice should be granted.

ORDERED, That the parties' joint motion to dismiss this complaint, with prejudice, is granted. It is, further,
