APPLICATION

The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L"), Applicant herein, is an Ohio corporation engaged in the business of supplying electric generation, transmission, and distribution service to approximately 450,000 consumers in Ohio. As such, DP&L is a public utility as defined by Sections 4905.02 and 4905.03 of the Ohio Revised Code and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission").

DP&L commences this proceeding to obtain the Commission's approval of a bill format change pursuant to the Finding and Order in Case No. 07-1252-EL-ATA and O.A.C. sections 4901:1-10-22(C) and 4901:1-1-33(F). DP&L hereby requests approval of the sample bill formats attached as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2. Exhibit 1 is a sample format depicting the front of a standard offer bill and Exhibit 2 is a sample format of the back of a standard offer bill.

Pursuant to the April 30, 2008 Finding and Order in Case No. 07-1252-EL-ATA, the location of the approved Rate Stabilization Surcharge ("RSS") rider, which currently appears in DP&L's distribution service tariffs, is to be relocated to the generation service tariffs. The proposed bill change reflects the removal of the RSS from distribution charges into a non by-passable generation rider charge. DP&L's proposed bill revisions

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
also modify the back of the bill to include a definition of "Generation Rider," to reflect the new format and location.

The proposed bill formats comply with the provisions of O.A.C. Sections 4901:1-10-22(B) and 4901:1-10-33(C), in addition to complying with the Commission's April 30, 2008 Finding and Order as described above.


### CONCLUSION

DP&L respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application to revise DP&L's current billing formats for both its residential and nonresidential customers to comply with both the requirements of O.A.C. Sections 4901:1-10-22 and 4901:1-10-33 as well as the April 30, 2008 Finding and Order in Case No. 07-1252-EL-ATA. DP&L further requests such approval to be effective July 14, 2008.

**EXPLANATION OF BILLING TERMS****ACTUAL READING**

A reading taken from your meter.

**CUSTOMER CHARGE**

The fixed monthly basic distribution charge to partially cover costs for billing, meter reading, service line maintenance and equipment.

**DISTRIBUTION CHARGE**

Charge for moving electricity over electric distribution lines to your home or business.

**TRANSMISSION  
RELATED CHARGES**

The amount the utility or a supplier charges for operating and maintaining the electric transmission system.

**ESTIMATED READING**

(EST or E) On the months we do not read your meter, we calculate your bill based on your past usage. Adjustments may be needed later when we take an actual meter reading. If you would like to read your own meter to avoid estimated bills, call the account information number on the front of the bill with your meter reading.

**GENERATION CHARGE**

Charge associated with production of electricity. For residential customers, the generation charge on your bill reflects the 5 percent reduction required by the Ohio Legislature.

**GENERATION RIDER**

Charge associated with recovery of certain costs related to the production of electricity. DP&L will continue to collect this charge from customers even if they choose to switch to another generation supplier.

**GENERATION CREDIT**

If you are purchasing your generation from another supplier, the amount DP&L is removing from your bill.

**KILOWATT-HOUR (KWH)**

The unit measure for electricity. For example, you use one kilowatt-hour of electricity to light a 100-watt bulb for 10 hours.

**LATE PAYMENT CHARGE**

A 1 1/2% late charge added to the overdue amount if you do not pay your bill by the due date for prompt payment.
