ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 12, 2008, Eric L. Elliott (complainant) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., (Columbia) alleging that Columbia failed to properly terminate gas service.
- (2) On March 19, 2008, the Columbia filed a motion to dismiss the complaint, stating that the dispute had been resolved.
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that, when a public utility files a motion stating that the case has been settled, the complainant shall file a response within 20 days. If no response is filed, the Commission may presume that settlement has occurred and may dismiss the complaint.
- (4) The complainant in this case has filed no response to Columbia's motion to dismiss. Therefore, the Commission presumes that the case is settled and that, in light of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss be granted. It is, further,


