The Commission finds:

- On November 6, 2007, Joan G. Harker and Shawn D. Harker filed a complaint alleging unfair and unjust billing practices by Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia).
- (2) On May 2, 2008, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss the complaint stating that the parties have resolved all the issues raised in the complaint. Columbia stated that, since nothing more remains to be done, the complaint should be dismissed as a settled case.
