**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF SUBURBAN NATURAL GAS COMPANY'S MOTION TO
REOPEN AND FOR ENFORCEMENT OF FINDING AND ORDER OR, IN THE
ALTERNATIVE, STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF
WITHDRAWAL OF JOINT MOTION OF SUBURBAN NATURAL GAS COMPANY AND
COLUMBIA GAS OF OHIO FOR ADDITIONAL STAY**


On December 11, 2007, Suburban Natural Gas Company ("Suburban") filed its Motion to Reopen and for Enforcement of Finding and Order Entered January 18, 1996 in Subject Proceedings Approving Joint Stipulation and Recommendation ("Motion to Reopen"). In the Motion to Reopen, Suburban, in the alternative, asked that its motion and supporting memorandum be treated as a complaint pursuant to R.C. 4905.26 (the "Complaint"). On December 31, 2007, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss. On January 15, 2008 and February 19, 2008, Suburban and Columbia Gas of Ohio ("Columbia") (collectively, Suburban and Columbia are herein after "Parties") filed joint motions for stays of the proceedings, the latter being for an indefinite stay in order for the Parties to pursue settlement discussions.

Suburban hereby notifies the Commission that, with the concurrence of Columbia, it withdraws the Motion to Reopen without prejudice to its rights to re-file. In the alternative, the Parties jointly

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stipulate to the dismissal of the Complaint without prejudice pursuant to Civ. R. 41(A)(1)(b). Additionally, because of the withdrawal of the Motion to Reopen or, in the alternative, the dismissal of the Complaint without prejudice, the Parties withdraw their Joint Motion for Additional Stay.
