Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14. Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

<u>Transmittal No. 932</u> – Effective July 18, 2008 With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to introduce a new contract tariff option. This new option will provide a customer with discounts and billing credits on Special Access High Capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Services to customers who meet certain eligibility requirements and maintain a minimum number of DS1 and DS3 transport miles. The customer can obtain additional billing credits by converting seventy-five percent (75%) of its DS1 unbundled loops and DS1 unbundled transport to Special Access DS1 channel terminations and channel mileage, respectively
