PETITION OBJECTING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF HIGH VOLTAGE ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES OVER THE MAPLE HIGHLANDS TRAIL (OPERATED BY THE PARK DISTRICT) AND THROUGH THE CITY OF CHARDON.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Power Siting Board is urging American Transmission Systems, Inc. to consider constructing high voltage transmission lines over the Maple Highlands Trail and through the City of Chardon, Ohio; and
