ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner, in carrying out the authority granted by Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), finds:

- (1) A settlement conference was conducted in this case, on June 10, 2008, in lieu of the scheduled evidentiary hearing, as respondent retained counsel immediately before the scheduled hearing. During the June 10, 2008 settlement conference, the Attorney Examiner granted additional time for the parties to attempt to resolve the issues in this case. Subsequent case status conferences were conducted by teleconference on July 1 and July 14, 2008, yet the parties were unable to resolve the issues in this case.
- (2) Accordingly, a hearing on the merits of this complaint should be set for Tuesday, September 9, 2008, to begin at 1:00 p.m., in Hearing Room 11-G, on the 11th floor of the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
- (3) The parties are reminded that, in Commission proceedings, the complainant has the burden of proving the allegations in the complaint. It shall be the complainant's responsibility to appear at the hearing and to be prepared to present evidence at the hearing in support of its complaint.


