MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION

OAC 4901:1-27-02 allows a governmental entity to apply in order to become a governmental aggregator to offer or provide competitive retail natural gas service. The City of Crestline applied and was granted to be a governmental aggregator in 2003, pursuant to OAC 4901:1-27-06.

A governmental aggregator must re-apply to have its certification renewed no later than thirty days before the expiration of the aggregator's certificate, but no earlier than one hundred and twenty days. OAC 4901:1-27-09. The City of Crestline's certification is set to expire on August 19, 2008. The renewal application must have been filed before July 20, 2008. The City of Crestline filed its renewal application on August 8, 2008.


The City of Crestline asks that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio grant an extension on the City of Crestline's certification expiration date listed on its certificate. The reasons for the extension are that the City of Crestline's former Safety-Service Director, Gene Toy, resigned in late January, 2008. His assistant, Marc Milliron, filled as much of this position as possible until the Mayor appointed someone to fill the vacancy. The Mayor filled the position on February 25, 2008.

Due to not immediately knowing the City of Crestline was a governmental aggregator of natural gas service, the new Safety-Service, Tyson Quail, did not file in a timely manner with PUCO the renewal of the City of Crestline's certificate.

Also, the City of Crestline is advised by Terry Leach with Amp-Ohio concerning its aggregator certificates. Mr. Leach was unaware of Mr. Toy's resignation from the City of Crestline. Mr. Leach had been sending e-mails to Mr. Toy in order for the City to renew its certificate. However, Mr. Leach's e-mails were never received. Upon learning that Mr. Quail is now the Safety-Service Director of Crestline, he immediately sent the appropriate documents to Mr. Quail, which were executed. Unfortunately, the documents were filed with PUCO too late.

Due to the administration change that occurred within the City of Crestline, the City asks that it be granted extension on its certification expiration date so that the City can file its renewal application before thirty days of the expiration date on the certificate.
