American Transmission Systems, Incorporated (ATSI), and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), subsidiaries of FirstEnergy Corp., are proposing to construct the Geauga County 138 kV Transmission Line Project ("Project"). This letter briefly describes the Project, the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) certification process and provides you with a notice of the date and location of upcoming public hearings on the Project.

The scope of the proposed Project involves installing a proposed 138 kV electric transmission line that will largely be supported on wood poles. Preferred and Alternate Routes for the Project have been proposed. The proposed Preferred Route largely follows a cross-country route originating at a new substation that will be built to the west of CEI's existing Huntsburg Substation on Mayfield Road in Huntsburg Township. From there, the preferred route will run north for approximately 14.7 miles, through portions of Huntsburg, Montville and Thompson Townships in Geauga County and into Madison Township in Lake County, where it will interconnect with ATSI's existing 138 kV Ashtabula-Mayfield transmission line. The proposed Alternate Route largely follows a road corridor route that will be located immediately adjacent to Clay Street, and will originate at a new substation that will be built near the intersection of Clay Street and Mayfield Road in Huntsburg Township. 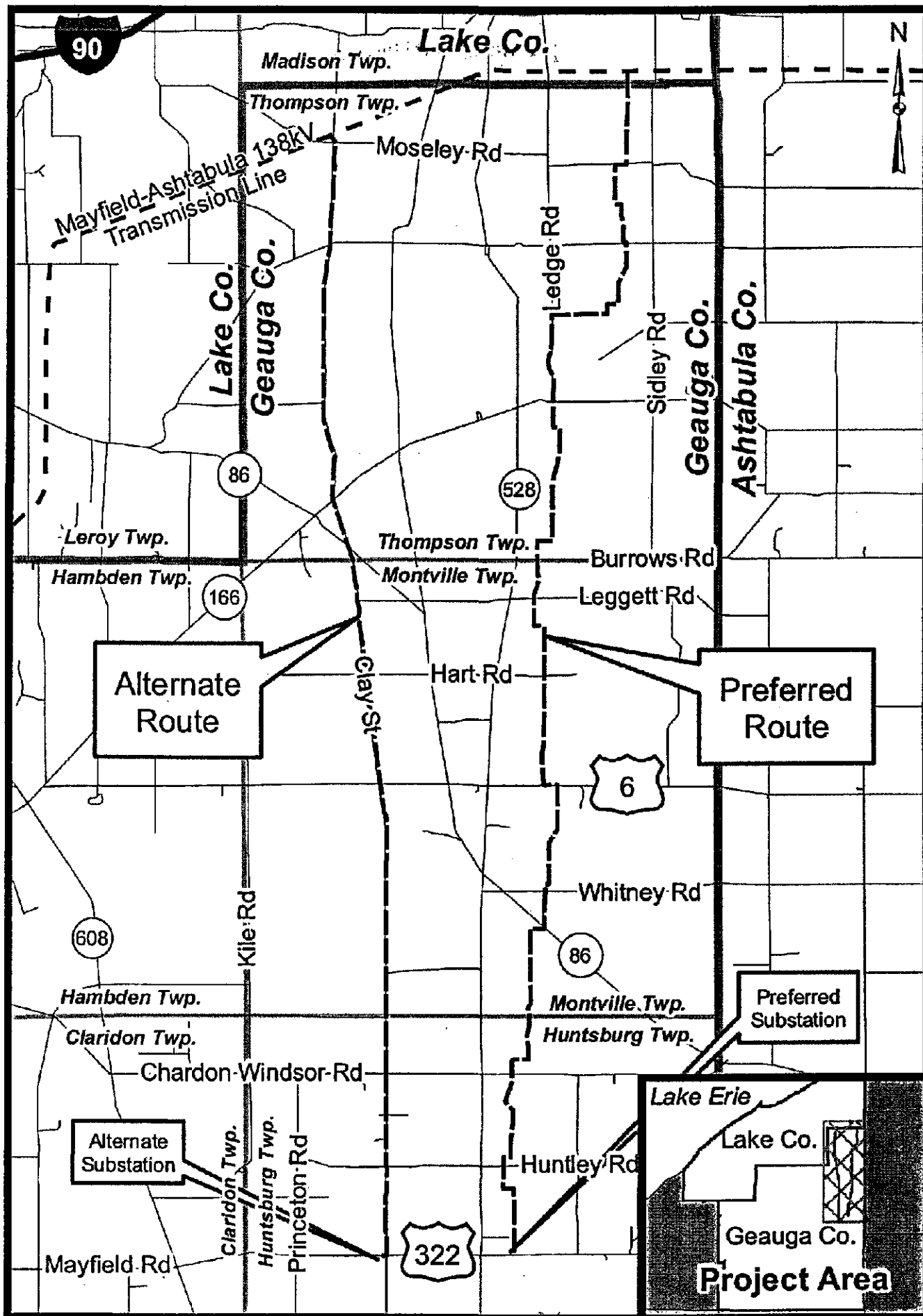

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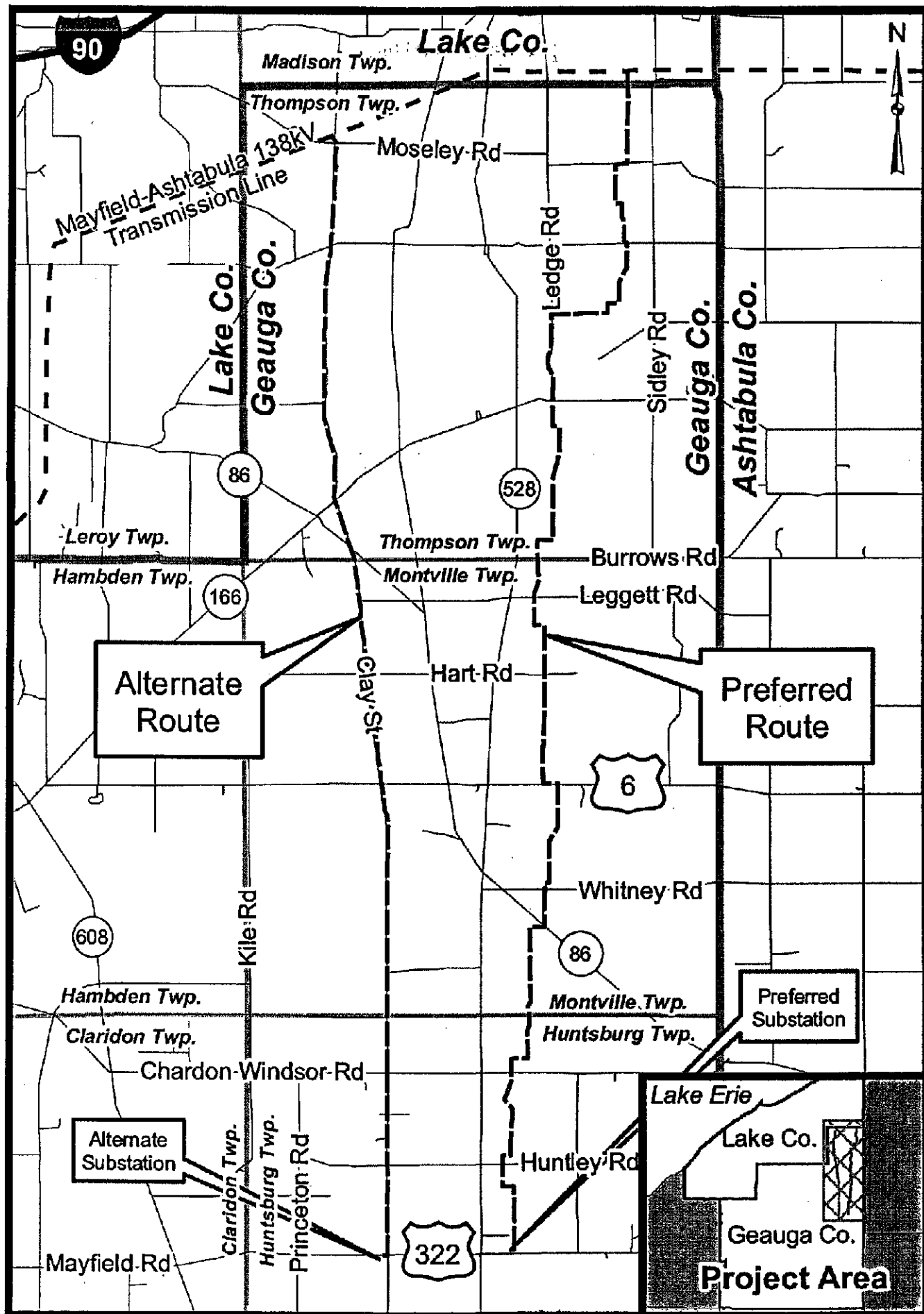
