## <u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 7, 2007, Northeast Ohio Neighborhood Health Services, Inc. (NEON or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T). In its complaint, NEON alleges that AT&T has billed NEON improperly and has not provided adequate service.
- (2) AT&T filed an answer to the complaint on May 29, 2007. In its answer, AT&T contends that the matters asserted in the complaint arise from NEON's own acts and omissions.
- (3) On July 24, 2007, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling this matter for a mediated settlement conference. The parties engaged in negotiations on July 31, 2007, but did not reach an agreement at that time. Ultimately, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter to be heard on August 26, 2008.
- (4) By letter filed August 14, 2008, the parties informed the Commission that discussions have led to a mutually satisfactory resolution of the complaint. The parties, therefore, jointly request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) Understanding that the parties have reached a mutually satisfactory resolution of the complaint, the hearing in this matter should be canceled. Accordingly, the August 26, 2008, hearing shall be canceled, and this matter shall be submitted to the Commission for its consideration.
