Dear Public Utilities Commission of Ohio,

We are writing to you on behalf of the low-income individuals on the west side of Cleveland, whom we serve through the Home Weatherization Assistance Program. In addition to the insulation we add to the house, and the other work we do to reduce air infiltration, we also work with each household to teach people ways they can reduce their own utility usage. We encourage them to lower the thermostat, unblock heat registers & cold air returns, close all the windows and doors in the winter, and a host of other things to help them save money on their gas and light bills. In each house we go into, we explain the gas and electric bills to the residents. For many people this is the first time they actually understand the gas and light bills.

From working with low-income people and energy issues for over 25 years, we will tell you that utility bills are one of the biggest areas that contribute to feelings of powerlessness. People have no control over the *cost* of the gas and lights. They do, however, have some control over their own *usage*. In our program we try to empower people to be good stewards of our precious natural resources.

Please do not increase the monthly service charge to \$17.50 for all Dominion East Ohio customers. For many of the low-income individuals we serve this increase would make paying their monthly bill even more difficult.
