## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 23, 2008, Summit County, Ohio (Summit County or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T). In its complaint, Summit County alleged that AT&T has provided poor customer service and is imposing unconscionable contract terms that do not comply with Ohio law. In addition, Summit County alleges that AT&T has failed to provide Internet access line services.
- (2) On July 14, 2008, counsel for AT&T notified the Commission that the parties agreed to stay the procedural requirements for a formal complaint case. Counsel explained that the parties were confident that the issues could be resolved without assistance from the Commission.
- (3) By letter filed August 18, 2008, counsel for Summit County informed the Commission that the parties have settled this matter. Summit County, therefore, requested that the complaint be dismissed.
- (4) Upon being advised that the issues raised by the complaint have been resolved, the Commission finds that the request to dismiss the complaint should be granted.

It is, therefore,

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ORDERED, That, pursuant to the request of the complainant, the complaint filed in this matter is dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon Summit County and its counsel, AT&T and its counsel, and all interested persons of record.
