MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO INTERVENE OF ORMET PRIMARY ALUMINUM CORPORATION

Ormet Primary Aluminum Corporation ("Ormet") should be permitted to intervene in these matters pursuant to Section 4903.221, Ohio Revised Code and the Commission's Rules and Regulations contained in Section 4901-1-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code. The outcome of these proceedings could impact the rates Ormet pays for electricity.

Under Section 4903.221, any person who may be adversely affected by a Commission proceeding may intervene in such proceeding. The Commission's rules state that any person shall be permitted to intervene in a proceeding upon a showing that:

The person has a real and substantial interest in the proceeding, and the person is so situated that the disposition of the proceeding may, as a practical matter, impair or impede his or her ability to protect that interest, unless the person's interest is adequately represented by existing parties.¹

Ormet has a substantial interest in this proceeding. Ormet owns an aluminum reduction facility in Hannibal, Ohio. The reduction facility is physically located in the AEP zone of PJM,

and takes generation, transmission and distribution services from Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (collectively, "AEP Ohio") under an electric service agreement entered into in accordance with the Stipulation reached in Case No. 05-1057-EL-CSS, as modified by the Supplemental Agreement approved by the Commission in Case Nos. 07-1132-EL-UNC, et al. (collectively, "Agreement"). This Agreement between Ormet and AEP Ohio expires on December 31, 2008. If Ormet is unable to enter into a satisfactory replacement agreement with AEP Ohio, Ormet would be subject to AEP Ohio's standard service offer. Therefore, Ormet could be subject to the electricity rates approved as an outcome of this proceeding and has a substantial interest in this proceeding.

Ormet's facility contributes substantially to the economy in Monroe County, an extremely economically depressed area of Ohio. With its reduction facility in full operation, Ormet Primary (1) has 1,027 employees with wages totaling approximately \$56,000,000 per year; (2) covers approximately 7,000 of its workers', retirees', and family members' health care, at a cost of more than \$16,000,000 per year; (3) pays approximately \$300,000 annually in taxes to Monroe County and its School District; and (4) purchases approximately \$15,000,000 to \$20,000,000 per year in goods and services in the Ohio Valley.

Ormet is particularly sensitive to rate increases. Historically, power expense represents about 36 percent of the cost of producing aluminum. The aluminum business is very competitive, is very sensitive to overall economic conditions and normally survives on small margins. Ormet competes with smelters throughout the nation and the rest of the world, many of which pay much less for their power than does Ormet. Most – if not all – smelters facing delivered power costs higher than those paid by Ormet have been shut down.

In deciding whether to permit intervention under Section 4901-1-11(B), the Commission considers:

(1) the nature and extent of the prospective intervenor's interest;

(2) the legal position advanced by the prospective intervenor and its probable relation to

the merits of the case;

(3) whether the intervention by the prospective intervenor will unduly prolong or delay

the proceedings:

(4) whether the prospective intervenor will significantly contribute to the full

development and equitable resolution of the factual issues; and

(5) the extent to which the person's interest is represented by existing parties.

As described above, Ormet is a customer of AEP Ohio and could become subject to AEP

Ohio's standard service offer rates as of January 1, 2009, thus Ormet has an interest in ensuring

that AEP Ohio's rates remain just and reasonable. Ormet's intervention is timely and will not

unduly prolong or delay the proceedings. Ormet's unique relationship with AEP will also assist

in the full development and equitable resolution of the factual issues and indicates that no other

party can adequately represent Ormet's interest in these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Ormet respectfully requests that the Commission grant its motion to

intervene in this proceeding.
