ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 15, 2007, Edward D. Humphrey (Mr. Humphrey) filed a complaint against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L). Mr. Humphrey stated that he had resided at the service address since July 1998 and had an excellent payment history, but added that DP&L was now seeking an unreasonable deposit because of his late payment of a bill. Mr. Humphrey explained that the late bill payment was because of medical reasons.
- (2) DP&L filed its answer on December 6, 2007, denying Mr. Humphrey's complaint by asserting that DP&L had complied with all relevant statutes and regulations.
- (3) On January 16, 2008, Mr. Humphrey filed a letter stating that the matter had been resolved and that he no longer wishes to pursue his formal complaint.
- (4) Given the contents of Mr. Humphrey's January 16, 2008, letter, the Commission will dismiss Mr. Humphrey's complaint.

ORDERED, That the complaint filed by Mr. Humphrey be dismissed. It is, further,






