- (1) On November 15, 2007, Edward D. Humphrey (Mr. Humphrey) filed a complaint against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L). Mr. Humphrey stated that he had resided at the service address since July 1998 and had an excellent payment history, but added that DP&L was now seeking an unreasonable deposit because of his late payment of a bill.
