ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On July 31, 2008, Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (jointly AEP-Ohio, Companies) each filed an application for a standard service offer (SSO) pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code. Each application is for an electric security plan (ESP) in accordance with Section 4928.143, Revised Code. As part of the applications, AEP-Ohio filed a request for waiver of certain requirements. In its waiver request, AEP-Ohio noted that the Commission had issued proposed rules for the filing requirements in SSO applications in Case No. 08-777-ORD (08-777), *In the Matter of the Adoption of Rules for Standard Service Offer, Corporate Separation, Reasonable Arrangements, and Transmission Riders for Electric Utilities Pursuant to Sections 4928.14, 4928.17, and 4905.31, Revised Code, as Amended by Amended Substitute Senate Bill No. 221*, (Entry issued July 2, 2008). The Companies requested three waivers.
- (2) By entry issued September 19, 2008, each request for waiver was denied and AEP-Ohio was directed to file the pro forma financial information and the summary and detailed description of costs within 10 calendar days.
- (3) Upon further consideration of the directive to file within 10 calendar days and the Commission's recent adoption of new rules governing the SSO process, the Staff and AEP-Ohio should establish a reasonable timeline for submission of the

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financial information and descriptions necessary to supplement the Companies' SSO filings.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the Staff and AEP-Ohio establish a reasonable timeline for submission of the information necessary to supplement the SSO filings. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


