<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 6, 2007, the Commission issued an entry directing CSX Transportation, Inc., (CSX) to install active grade crossing devices at Hummel Road (141-939H) in Brook Park, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, by June 6, 2008.
- (2) On May 19, 2008, CSX filed a request for an extension of time to October 15, 2008, to complete the project. On May 20, 2008, the Commission staff filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission grant CSX's request for an extension of time. By entry dated June 4, 2008, the Commission granted CSX's request for an extension of time.
- (3) On September 15, 2008, CSX filed a request for a second extension of time to January 15, 2009, to complete the project. In its request, CSX stated that it had only recently received construction authorization from the Ohio Rail Development Commission and that roadway improvements required a redesign of the project. Therefore, CSX requested that a revised completion date of January 15, 2009, be granted for the construction of the project at Hummel Road.
- (4) On September 25, 2008, the Commission staff filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission grant CSX's request for a second extension of time.
- (5) The Commission finds that the request for a second extension of time to complete the project should be granted. Accordingly, CSX should complete the project by January 15, 2009.
