The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 18, 2008, Johnson Aviation (Complainant) filed a complaint against Windstream Communications (Windstream or Respondent) alleging that Windstream failed to complete service work scheduled for March 1, 2008, that involved moving a telephone line, moving a DSL line, and cancelling four telephone lines. Complainant also alleges that it was improperly billed for the work and services.
- (2) On October 3, 2008, the parties filed a joint motion to request that this case be dismissed. The parties also request that the Commission dismiss this case with prejudice, as this matter has been resolved to the satisfaction of the parties. The Commission finds that the parties' joint motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

ORDERED, That the parties' request to dismiss this complaint, with prejudice, be granted. It is, further,


