



Nature and Intent of Change, Customer Effect and Public Interest Consideration

Qwest Communications Corporation ("QCC") is a Delaware corporation with its principal office and place of business located at 1801 California Street, Denver, Colorado 80202. QCC is an affiliate of Qwest Corporation ("QC"), an incumbent local exchange carrier in fourteen (14) Midwestern and Western states. Both QCC and QC are wholly-owned by the same ultimate corporate parent company, Qwest Communications International, Inc. ("QCII"), a Delaware corporation whose stock is publicly traded on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol "Q".¹

QCC provides competitive voice, video, and data services principally to retail and wholesale enterprise, government, and business customers throughout the United States. QCC is authorized to provide various forms of telecommunication services in all 50 states, as well as the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico. In Ohio, QCC is authorized pursuant to its Certificate of Public Convenience & Necessity No. 90-9005 ("Certificate 90-9005") to provide local exchange services in sixty-one (61) of Ohio's eighty-eight (88) counties, and competitive telecommunication services statewide. Certificate 90-9005 was issued to QCC as a result of the consolidated proceedings at Case Nos. 01-1300-TP-ATR, 01-1301-CT-ATR, and 01-1302-CT-ZCO, Application of Qwest Communications Corporation, LCI International Telecom Corporation, Phoenix Network, Inc., and USLD Communications, Inc. for Authority to Transfer Operating Authority and Change Ownership, approval entry entered June 28, 2001.

In furtherance of its on-going efforts to streamline operations, QCC is in the process of converting its form of business from a corporation to a limited liability company under applicable provisions of Delaware law. Conversion will result in a modest name change of the company to Qwest Communications Company, LLC ("Qwest LLC"). The conversion is expected to be completed, and all regulatory approvals in place, on or about January 2, 2009.

In accordance with the Delaware statutory provisions, the steps in the conversion of QCC to Qwest LLC will be (a) approval of the conversion by QCC's Board of Directors and Shareholder, and (b) filing of a Certificate of Conversion to Limited Liability Company and a Certificate of Formation of Limited Liability Company with the Delaware Secretary of State. Upon filing these certificates with, and acceptance thereof by, the Delaware Secretary of State, Qwest LLC will be able to obtain issuance of a Certificate of Good Standing from the Delaware Secretary of State evidencing that Qwest LLC is a limited liability company, duly organized, and in good standing under the laws of the State of Delaware. Thereafter, Qwest LLC will promptly file a registration with the Ohio Secretary of State pursuant to Section 1705.54, Ohio Revised Code, to transact business in Ohio as a foreign limited liability company. Upon completion of that registration, Qwest LLC will promptly file with this Commission a certification from the Ohio Secretary of State as evidence of its good standing to transact business in the State of Ohio.

Delaware law specifies that a conversion from an incorporated entity to a limited liability company form of business does not create a new entity.² Upon conversion to a limited liability company under Delaware law, Qwest LLC will be deemed to be the same entity as, and will remain vested in the rights, privileges, powers, properties, assets, duties, liabilities, and obligations of QCC. There is no merger, transfer, or assignment of ownership, assets, services, or customers. As a result, for purposes of Ohio law and the rules of this Commission, the conversion here involves merely a change in name.

Other than the change in name, QCC's Ohio business will be unaffected by the proposed conversion. The conversion will not have any affect on the rates, terms, or conditions under which service is currently provided. As a consequence, other than the name change, the conversion will be completely transparent to existing Ohio customers. Customer notification is believed to be unnecessary due to the fact that the conversion will be completely transparent to Ohio customers. Regardless, out of an abundance of caution and in deference to the Commission's notice policies, Ohio customers are being advised of the name change through a market message or notation in their monthly bills or through a separate, similarly-worded letter or postcard.

QCC submits that the proposed name change is consistent with the public interest. The proposed name change is entirely *pro forma* in nature, and will not affect the rates, terms, and conditions of services provided to Ohio customers. Further, because immediately following the conversion Qwest LLC will continue to provide service under the "Qwest" brand name, the proposed change will be completely transparent to customers. At the same time, the conversion will achieve the stated purpose of streamlining operations, the result being reducing cost and financially strengthening the company so that it can compete more effectively. When so considered, the proposal is clearly in the public interest and should be approved.

² The Delaware Limited Liability Company Act ("DLLCA") establishes that the conversion from an incorporated entity to a limited liability company ("LLC") does not result in the creation of a new legal entity. This is evident with the acknowledgement under Section 18-214(g) of the DLLCA that "[w]hen an other entity has been converted to a limited liability company pursuant to this section, for all purposes of the laws of the State of Delaware, the limited liability company shall be deemed to be the same entity as the converting other entity and the conversion shall constitute a continuation of the existence of the converting other entity in the form of a domestic limited liability company." This is further evident with the premise under Delaware law that the existence of the LLC relates back to the date the corporation was first incorporated (see DLLCA, § 18-214(d) ["... the existence of the limited liability company shall be deemed to have commenced on the date the other entity commenced its existence in the jurisdiction in which the other entity was first created, formed, incorporated or otherwise came into being"]), and that "all rights of creditors and all liens upon any property of such other entity shall be preserved unimpaired, and all debts, liabilities and duties of the other entity that has converted shall remain attached to the domestic limited liability company." See DLLCA, § 18-214(f).

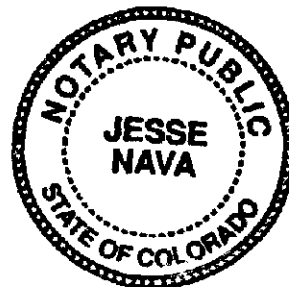
