## **ENTRY ON REHEARING**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) By finding and order issued September 17, 2008, the Commission adopted new rules concerning standard service offer, corporate separation, reasonable arrangements, and transmission riders for electric utilities pursuant to Sections 4928.14, 4928.17, and 4905.31, Revised Code. The newly adopted rules were set forth in the September 17, 2008, finding and order as new Chapters 4901:1-35, 4901:1-36, 4901:1-37, and 4901:1-38, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). The September 17, 2008, finding and order further rescinded existing Chapter 4901:1-35 and Rule 4901:1-20-16, O.A.C.
- (2) Applications for rehearing of the September 17, 2008, finding and order were filed on October 17, 2008, by Alliance for Real Energy Options, The Ohio Environmental Council, Duke Energy Ohio, jointly by Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (FirstEnergy), jointly by Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company, and collectively by the Ohio Consumer and Environmental Advocates.
- (3) Memorandum contra were filed by FirstEnergy, Industrial Energy Users-Ohio, and Ohio Consumer and Environmental Advocates on October 27, 2008.
