I will itemize my concerns
and questions.

1. Why get rid of the all electric discount
30 years ago when I built my house I was
promised this discount as long as I lived
in my house, and did not have any other
heat source at cooling. In spite of Electric
was still more than gas or oil.
2. Later my summer discount was taken
away because of public pressure. A company
that could stand the wrath of all the anti
Nuclear groups and build the Perry plant
gives in to a few consumer groups!
3. When gas was put on my street
approx. 10-12 years ago and I could
have signed up with bonus appliances from
the gas co, and free hookup. The Illumina
called me to ask if had hooked up to
gas and if I did I would lose my discount.
I was led to believe they were sending

an inspector to verify I had not. I stayed with The Illum. Co even though it was more expensive.

4 Power outages, all electric homes were supposed to get preference on outages. When 1st as a customer the longest I waited was 3-6 hours. Now it can be 3-6 days. I live approx. 2 miles from the Concord repair facility.

5. Finally The Illum. Co. wants to do away with my discount after years of paying more for my heat than comparable homes using oil or gas. Now with the changing energy market I am a burden.

In my opinion trusting the Illum. Co. To do the right thing is like getting a dog to guard the Butcher shop.

To convert my home to gas or oil would cost approx \$10,000.
