The Administrative Law Judge finds:

- (1) On December 19, 2008, Citizens Advocating Responsible Energy (CARE) filed an application for rehearing with respect to the Opinion, Order, and Certificate issued by the Board on November 24, 2008.
- (2) On December 22, 2008, American Transmission Systems, Inc. and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (jointly, the Companies) filed a motion seeking an extension of time to respond to CARE's application for rehearing. The Companies also request an expedited ruling on the motion, and represent that CARE does not object to an expedited ruling to the Companies' motion. In their motion, the Companies request an extension of time until Wednesday, January 7, 2009, to respond to CARE's application for rehearing due to the unavailability of staff and counsel during the holidays.
