ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 17, 2008, Ted Brown filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., (Columbia) regarding issues related to his gas line.
- (2) On November 12, 2008, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss, together with a memorandum in support, stating that the parties have resolved all of the issues in the complaint.
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that, when a public utility files a motion stating that the case has been settled, the complainant shall file a response within 20 days. If no response is filed, the Commission may presume that settlement has occurred and may dismiss the complaint.
- (4) The complainant in this case has filed no response to Columbia's motion to dismiss. Therefore, the Commission presumes that the case is settled and that, in light of the resolution of the complaint, Columbia's motion should be granted and this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Columbia's motion to dismiss be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 08-1170-GA-CSS be dismissed. It is, further,

 ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
