COMMENT DESCRIPTION:

DP&L rate plan thru 2010 - The proposed rate plan expects us to pay too big a share of the cost of the installation of their "smart grid" technology." The plan would allow DP&L to defer additional fuel costs and collect them from customers later, at a 13.3 percent rate of interest which includes a profit. DP&L should not be allowed to earn a profit for carrying costs on its books. The plan would also allow the company to bill residential customers for the cost of a discount provided to large commercial users of energy. If DP&L wants to give discounts, those discounts should not be recovered from the residential customers. They should come out of DP&L's profits. I ask the PUCO to take the side of the residential customer during this recession period and require DP&L to not unfairly burden the residential customer.
