## Dear Examiner Jones:

Through this letter the Ohio Power Siting Board Staff (Staff) addresses the Company's motion for a waiver of the one-year notice requirement of Section 4906.06(A)(6), Revised Code. Regardless of the route selected by the Board in this case, Staff acknowledges that coordination with local jurisdictions will be critical. The Applicant has demonstrated that such coordination has already begun, in turn delaying the filing of the application from early to late 2008. The Applicant asserts that the need, or end result of the project has not changed.

Staff does not object to the Applicant's request for waiver of this requirement should the application be approved by the Board. The Staff, however, reserves the right to investigate and contest any other issue presented in the application.
