For its Entry of December 3, 2008, the Commission directed Norfolk Southern to file a report by January 30, 2009 advising as to the status of the Miamisburg Corridor Project.

In response, Norfolk Southern has completed the preliminary engineering estimates which have been provided to the Ohio Rail Development Commission ("ORDC") for its review, input, and approval. The ORDC has completed its field review (which recognized certain utility issues which need to be addressed), and is in the final stages of reviewing the estimates, with an anticipated completion date of February 11, 2009.

On or before February 25, 2009, Norfolk Southern and the ORDC intend to prepare and forward to the City of Miamisburg a formal letter proposal regarding all ten of the grade crossings at issue, including Kercher Street.

The interested parties (specifically, representatives of Norfolk Southern, the ORDC, and the City of Miamisburg) are then scheduled to meet in Miamisburg on March 25, 2009, toward furthering their attempt to finalize a mutually-beneficial agreement providing for improvements to the majority of Miamisburg's crossings versus the closure of at least certain crossings. (Per the preliminary engineering estimates, and due to prospective frequency saturation, it appears that at least certain crossings will need to be closed, toward allowing for the improvements.)

Constructive dialogue remains ongoing, as these parties continue their efforts with respect to this significant corridor project.

Assuming the Commission's approval, Norfolk Southern will file a further status report by the end of March of 2009.
