I am a residential customer from Dayton, Ohio. I am unable to attend the public hearing of Dayton Power and Light's proposal this Thursday, but would like my concerns known.

Concerning DPL's proposed electric security plan, I do support a more advanced electric system and provision for energy efficiency programs for residential customers. The plan with the additional rate increase based on customer conservation and energy management is long overdue. I have been very energy conservative all my life.
