Dear Ms. Jenkins:

KOREnergy, Ltd. (KOREnergy) is a curtailment service provider headquartered in Columbus, Ohio. KOREnergy is registered with PJM and permitted to aggregate retail customers into demand response programs. If due to excessive demand, storm damage, generation outage or other reason load must be curtailed on the PJM system to maintain stability, PJM may call upon KOREnergy to curtail the demand it provides curtailment services to. KOREnergy as the registered curtailment service provider is responsible to ensure the pledged reductions take place. If for some reason the curtailment does not take place KOREnergy will be penalized. To fulfill its obligation KOREnergy has an information system set up to quickly notify customers if they have to curtail and monitor to make sure the curtailment has been accomplished.

Because of the size of the payments, the current economic downturn and a sense of civic responsibility, many Ohio businesses have enrolled or desire to enroll in the upcoming PJM planning year June 1, 2009 to May 31<sup>st</sup> 2010. Unfortunately, beginning last week American Electric Power has refused to process applications for any of its Ohio customers who are on standard service. Since American Electric Power has less than one percent of its customers shopping, the unilateral ban imposed by American Electric Power virtually denies all Ohio business located in their service area from participating in the PJM demand response programs.

Ohio businesses should not be disadvantage by being denied access to the PJM demand response programs. For that reason KOREnergy urges the Commission to grant the motion for a cease and desist order requested by Intergys Energy Services and Constellation NewEnergy. Further, because enrollment in the PJM demand response programs are limited, the Commission should issue the order as soon as possible.
