Like our parents, David and Tamar, we would like to formally state our objection to the current request by American Electric Power to increase rates by 15% over the next 3 years. We feel that this is excessive (bills would actually rise 52% when comparing from the beginning to the end of the rate hike) and inappropriate at this time.
