1 Thursday Morning Session, February 19, 2009. 2 3 4 BOJKO: Let's go back on the EXAMINER 5 record. 6 This is a continuation of Case No. 7 08-1094-EL-SSO, et al., being in the Matter of the 8 Application of the Dayton Power and Light Company for 9 approval of its electric security plan. 10 My name is Kim Bojko.
