#### AMENDMENT NO. ONE

# TO WIRELESS INTERCONNECTION AND RECIPROCAL COMPENSATION AGREEMNT BETWEEN KALIDA TELEPHONE COMPANY AND SPRINT SPECTRUM L.P. - TO INCLUDE NEXTEL WEST CORP.

This Amendment No. One to the Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement ("Amendment No. One or "Amendment") is made by and between Kalida Telephone Company, Inc., an Ohio Corporation, ("Kalida") and Sprint Spectrum, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, with offices located at 6330 Sprint Parkway, Overland Park, Kansas 66251 ("Sprint"). This Amendment shall be deemed effective as of January 1, 2009, subject to the approval of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission").

#### 1. RECITALS

WHEREAS Kalida Telephone Company and Sprint Spectrum, L.P. entered into a Wireless Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement effective as of October 1, 2000 (the "Agreement") and approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

WHEREAS Kalida Telephone Company and Sprint wish to amend the Agreement to include Nextel West Corp;

WHEREAS Nextel West Corp. is a provider of Commercial Mobile Radio Services (CMRS) licensed by the Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS Kalida and Nextel West Corp. exchange Local Telecommunications Traffic between their respective networks.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in this Amendment, the parties wish to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The Agreement is hereby amended to include Nextel West Corp. as a contracting party to the Agreement.
- 2 For all purposes under the Agreement any reference to Sprint PCS shall mean Sprint and shall include Sprint Spectrum L. P. and Nextel West Corp.
- 3. Kalida and Nextel West Corp. agree to compensate each other and will issue separate invoices to each other on a going forward basis from the effective date of this Amendment.
