ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 30, 2007, Lester J. Lemke filed a complaint against Toledo Edison Company (TE) regarding the interconnection of his wind turbine with TE's system and TE's net-metering billing practices. On May 17, 2007, TE filed its answer to the complaint.
- (2) By entry dated January 23, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for hearing on March 16, 2009. Subsequently, on March 4, 2009, the parties filed a joint motion for a continuance in order to allow time for further settlement discussion regarding the issues raised by the complaint. The parties request that the hearing be continued indefinitely but represent that they will provide the attorney examiner with a status update by May 4, 2009.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the motion for a continuance should be granted. If necessary, a new hearing date will be scheduled by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion for a continuance be granted. It is, further,
