## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 29, 2009, Michael L. Nicholson (complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against The East Ohio Gas Company, dba Dominion East Ohio (Dominion). In the complaint, complainant alleged that an incorrect identification of his account by Dominion as being 60 days in arrears, when his account actually was paid up, lead to a rejection of his requested enrollment with MxEnergy.
- (2) On March 25, 2009, a settlement conference was held in an attempt to informally resolve this matter. The parties were unable to reach a resolution of the issue presented in the complaint. Further, it appears that reasonable grounds for complaint have been presented.
- (3) Accordingly, a hearing in this matter should be scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on May 21, 2009, in the offices of the Commission, hearing room 11-F, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.
- (4) In Commission proceedings, the complainant has the burden of proving the allegations in the complaint. Thus, at hearing, it shall be the complainant's responsibility to appear and be prepared to present evidence in support of the complaint.
