ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 21, 2008, Samantha and Paula Wilkins filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia), alleging overbilling due to a faulty meter.
- (2) On November 13, 2008, Columbia filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) Columbia has filed a motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the company stated that the complainant and Columbia have resolved all the issues raised in the complaint. Further, citing Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Columbia stated that the complaint should be dismissed as a settled case.
- (4) Rule 4901-9-01(F), O.A.C., provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Columbia's motion has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served on each party of record.
