ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 17, 2008, Louis A. Green and Associates (Green) filed a complaint against Cincinnati Bell in which it alleged that Cincinnati Bell overcharged for long distance and Internet service. Green also alleged that Cincinnati Bell improperly terminated its Internet services resulting in economic loss to Green.
- (2) On January 12, 2009, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company, LLC, Cincinnati Bell Extended Territories LLC, and Cincinnati Bell Any Distance Inc. (collectively Cincinnati Bell) filed an answer to the complaint.
- (3) By entry issued March 18, 2009, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a prehearing settlement conference to be held on April 21, 2009.
- (4) On April 8, 2009, the complainant filed a letter in which he requested that the prehearing conference be scheduled for a later date to avoid a conflict with another matter.
- (5) The complainant's request to postpone the prehearing conference shall be granted. The prehearing conference will be rescheduled for May 5, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 11-B at the offices of the Commission located at 180 East Broad St., Columbus, Ohio 43215.


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
It is, therefore,
